

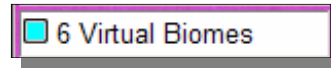
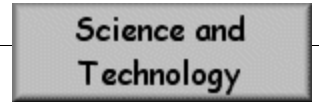

From what you have learned about **permafrost**, can you explain in **your own words** why there are so few plants in the **tundra**?



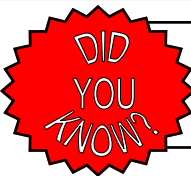
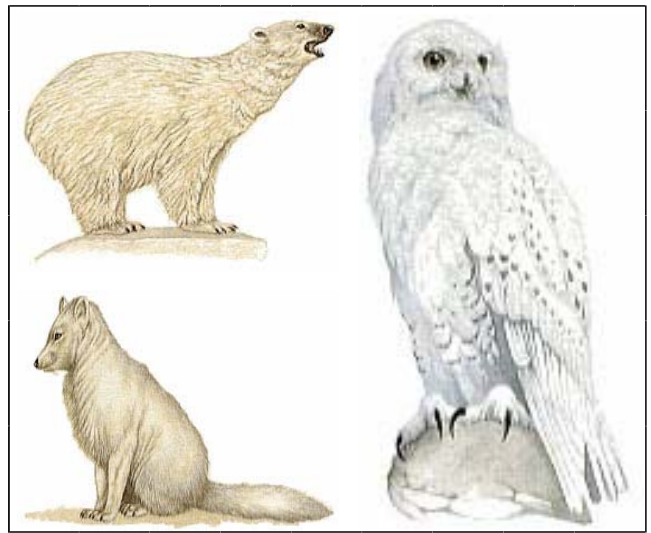
