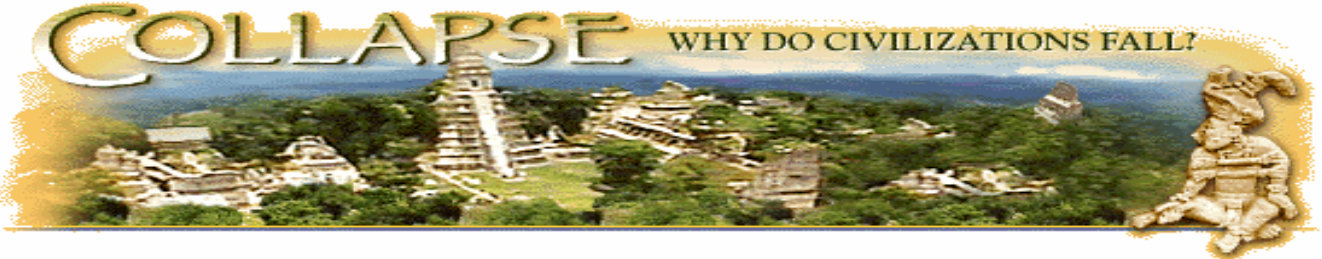

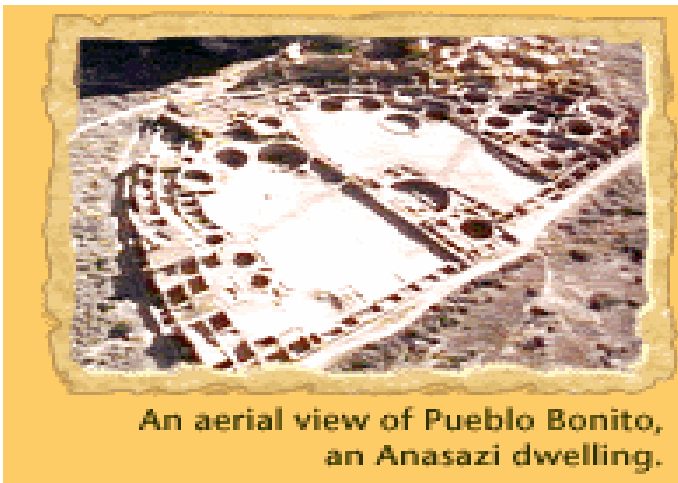

In **your own words**, describe what Pueblo Bonita was like at its peak.

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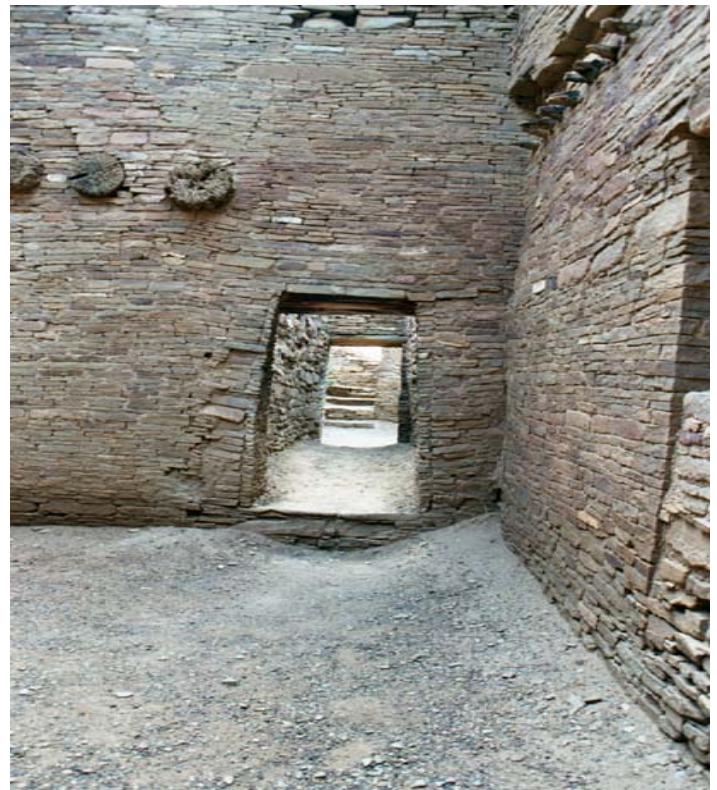
