### 1. Before you click on *anything*

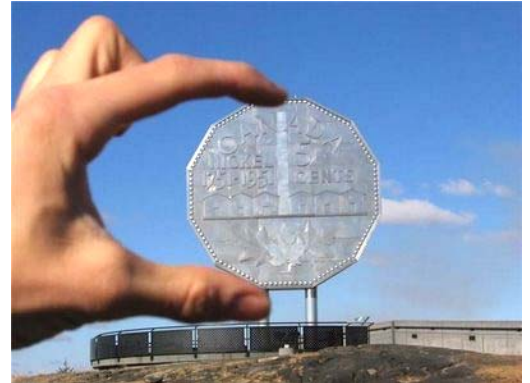

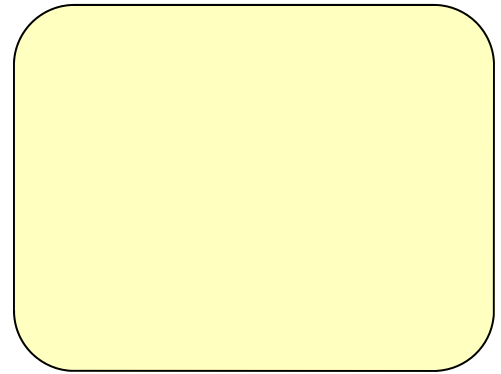
