We're going to Switzerland to the **Nobel e-Museum**, (centre column).

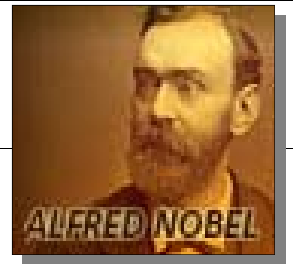
People all around the world have won the Nobel Prize, in many different fields. There are several **Canadians** that are listed among the recipients.

3. Back at the menu bar, click on **NOBEL PRIZES** In what six fields are Nobel Prizes given?






